Ten weeks now and no response. I started by contacting THLN since it already has established contacts in the Legislature. If you intend to take no action to help uninformed pet guardians and their treasured animals avoid tremendous suffering because more people are uninformed than those who are informed realize, please tell me so I can go directly to the legislators. I can't live thinking my dog died a horrible death for nothing, being slowly suffocated over a period of three weeks, it was easily avoidable with timely and inexpensive action years before, and all people want to talk about is spay for overpopulation. Then people don't spay because "it's an only dog" and "we don't let her run loose" and that's all they know. This was all avoidable. My dog continued missing chances to realize her lifespan potential. Over and over we had contact with people who could have warned about mammary cancer. Mobile rabies vaccination clinics for one. I never heard word one from anyone. She climbed the fence in 2008, was picked up by animal control, I went to get her out, no one told me anything, no warning sign on a wall, nothing! I notice I was placed on THLN email list. Well, in unrelated matter, I contacted many members of the USA House and Senate regarding rampant false pretense financial crimes taking place on You Tube in an unabashed welter of corruption. Not one response as to any action re this consumer fraud. But some did place me on their email list. Action is needed re issues,

welter of corruption. Not one response as to any action re this consumer fraud. But some did place me on their email list. Action is needed re issues, mailing lists alone won't get it done. I got an American Veterinary Medical Association flyer at a shelter and all it says re spay is "overpopulation."

I'm becoming cynical now and thinking they don't want to mention mammary cancer as a spay reason because they'd miss out on many four figure surgeries due to people falling through the cracks and remaining uninformed as in "why take the dog to the veterinarian unless it's sick." So they might resist the law I proposed as it could dent their revenues, and I know they have a significant lobby. Lots of people buy dogs from breeders, we had two that way over the years, no one warned about mammary cancer, the rest, mostly males, we took in as abandoned and they never went through any shelter. But vets can't be silent on overpopulation. Veterinarians may even have pressured adoption groups and shelters to let this not spayed/mammary tumor hazard aspect go unmentioned. There has to be a reason why, as these are not stupid people, but what about ethics? When I don't see them mentioning what they could with just a few words or a sign in the waiting area, there must be a reason, and money appears to be an overriding reason for so much wrong in society. Appearances suggest this is the case. I had a dog who had a painful ulcer from one Rimadyl, now last June the vet who took off another growth from Capa sent us home with Rimadyl, no warning! Lots of consumer complaints on web re Rimadyl.

Time? I have written over three million words of research in unrelated area and did it all for free in the public interest and am well known in some circles. As of 3:00 PM on Wednesday July 18 my dog had the most awful expression of terror on her face I have ever seen as if to say "Charles please HELP me!" Two hours later she was dead with oxygen tube at the vets that did enable me to say goodbye as I saw her left eye pop open. Now deceased and decomposing in her resting place she is asking SOMEONE for help save other dogs from this miserable fate as she was very sociable with other dogs and would be happy to know someone would help them to escape the catastrophe that fell on her. We missed two to five additional years together because no one got word to me when they so easily could have. You may have taken some action but inasmuch as I am not psychic how would I know unless notified? My father used to tell me "if you need to get something done, get a busy person to do it." You started out with a burst of enthusiasm and it was you, not I, who stated a time frame for being apprised of some forward steps, and this appears to have muted down to nothing. I tell you, I am <u>CRUSHED</u>! Sure other things are in the hopper but how about this? Note the tone of her reply dated August 2 sounded quite positive. After 11 weeks (77 days) passed I again messaged her (will forward to anyone on request) and again no response. Bobosky not only never responded as she

Bobosky not only never responded as she indicated she would, but she declined any further comment, probably so I wouldn't have any more in writing from her than she already provided. You'd be forced to this conclusion were you in my place. I want others in THLN to be fully aware of what she has apparently rejected. This is inexplicable why a purported animal welfare activist would decline to pursue a bill designed to prevent a significant segment of pet owners from falling through the cracks, resulting in probably several thousand dogs annually in Texas dying early of preventable mammary cancer due to they had no idea there's a link between hormone retention and mutations to mammary DNA! She provided me with a phone number; however, inasmuch as after nearly

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encounter a strong neadwind or opposition. She sent no proposed amended version. Just no response at all. Now fellow animal welfare activists, I personally watched my dog die of cancer that started as mammary (had surgeries), finally migrated to her lungs, and once it arrived there, she lasted less than three weeks. X ray on June 6 showed clear, X ray on July 2 showed neoplasm at the top of her lungs. Cancer is notoriously difficult to battle. 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I had to witness my dog's decline in breathing capacity from June 30 when she collapsed on a two-thirds mile walk, to 3:00 PM Wednesday, July 18, 2018, when she barely had enough breath to be able to stand and with a look of *unmitigated terror* on her face, to rushing her to the veterinary clinic where she got an oxygen tube and it revived her enough for her eyes to pop open and I had chance to whisper my goodbyes into her left ear before the death needle hit a vein in her left rear leg and she was gone in seconds. My dog always had wonderful lung capacity. Absent this, she'd have been with me 2 to 5 more years as she was in great condition all other ways. The second reason for early spay is being minimized so much that a serious number of pet owners are completely unaware, until trouble starts! Recently I additionally learned that unspayed dogs are not only at risk of mammary tumors, but they also are at risk of pyometra, an infection that can be deadly. When I found out about pyometra, I suddenly realize that's the likeliest cause of the death in 1968 of Tootse,

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found out about pyometra, I suddenly realize that's the likeliest cause of the death in 1968 of Tootse, mother of my Deputy Dog (1967-1978) as I always remembered hearing she died of an infection; pyometra is a new word to me as of August 2018. People cannot adequately care for pets when they don't know two simple things about spay that the spay and neuter crowd is doing a poor job of mentioning---mammary cancer and pyometra. To be told of these two other aspects of spay hardly constitutes completing a veterinary degree and would take only a faint amount of added effort on the part of people emphasizing spay.

An entire significant group of people with pets is being irresponsibly and outrageously neglected as to the

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An entire significant group of people with pets is being irresponsibly and outrageously neglected as to the information they are entitled to have. Entitled; that is, if others will treat them and their pets with basic decency! This is no demand that anyone conduct a door to door campaign! I have contained several stray dogs over the years fearing they'd be struck by traffic. All had tags and phone numbers. All were picked up by appreciative families. In the month of October 2018, for the second time, I helped a loose dog in Irving Texas get home; and have email correspondence with City of Irving Animal Control to prove it. Now, how about protecting more dogs from cancer that can be avoided?

I ask all of you sincerely, try holding your breath beyond your ability by only ten seconds---how desperate and distressed does this make you? Imagine being unable to get any relief, progressively sinking into unconsciousness, your neck going limp and your head turning by the pull of gravity, and you cannot even so much as scream due to no breath, and now after who knows how many tragedies like this one, easily avoidable had the pet guardian been better informed at an early stage, and someone who represents

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much as scream due to no breath, and now after who knows how many tragedies like this one, easily avoidable had the pet guardian been better informed at an early stage, and someone who represents themselves that they deeply care about companion animals, won't do anything to rescue, by way of a legislation to ensure preventative dispensing of information through appropriate sources, thousands of treasured pets to avoid this extreme catastrophic fate? Have any of you ever seen a dog's healthy pink tongue transition to deathly blue from insufficient oxygen? I have never seen anything so ominous! This was my soul mate we are talking about, and she was my ONLY source of unconditional acceptance!

This is no proposal of a universal mandatory spay law, but rather ways the system can make more people aware of the cancer related hazard of not being spayed early. There are two female dogs next door; one 12, the other older. Both spayed early and both acting quite robust. My dog barely lived past age eleven and wasn't spayed till much later than the two neighbor dogs as I was totally out of the information loop. The next door neighbors are new as of April 2018 so it's not like they had a chance to inform me in

The next door neighbors are new as of April 2018 so it's not like they had a chance to inform me in 2008 when spay would have protected my dog. It's outrageous that her heart, liver, kidneys, brain, eyes, ears, spleen were all in great condition, but her lungs were invaded and ruined. All due to insufficient information campaign by those in best positions to dispense it.

If you had a dog that died this way, what would be your view of people who declined to act to ensure that others get warned and informed timely to prevent such awful end of their pet's lives? Capa, full formal name was "Capogens"---my Honey Heart slept in bed with me over 3,700 nights---now, picture her slowly suffocating in the last six hours of her life due to the cancer progression which wasn't averted by early spay due to no info---

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This is NOT about who do you have the better opinion of, Bobosky or of me! Popularity contests be damned! It's about doing the right thing to save thousands of dogs and their families to avoid needless suffering, frightful deaths and years of treasured companionship lost! For many retired persons, their dog is their sole live in companion! As years progress, more women than men are

As years progress, more women than men are alone, and often their dog is their sole companion; why are we letting people be "destroyed for lack of knowledge?" Why only protect MOST dogs from mammary tumors? Why not seek to have the most people as possible in the vital information loop?

My legislative proposal, "Capa's Law," requires no billboards, no TV, radio, newspaper nor magazine ads, no mass mailing campaign to millions of addresses. Read the proposal!

The neighbor dogs will die of simple old age, a slowly failing liver perhaps, with far less tragedy than the death of my dog. Had I received info early, she and I would have had 750 to 1,800 more days and nights together. We went on thousands of outings. Outings twice daily. She commuted with me daily to the elderly residents home where my mother is and Capa brought much delight to residents. Capa had no bad

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elderly residents home where my mother is and Capa brought much delight to residents. Capa had no bad habits, never needed any training and was exceptionally intelligent, recognizing many words and what to do in response.

You must read the attached document before responding. You have to get the entire picture.

Maybe you want to consider an ouster of Ms. Bobosky. However, that is not my objective. My objective is stated here and in the attachment. I am crushed that she has refused response after her initial response appeared so affirmative. We have a social duty to others to dispense valuable Keys of Knowledge that will prevent suffering and are conscience bound to do so and must not blithely assume "oh, everyone knows that" because fellow Texans, no! Everyone does not know! There's no one who knows everything, and many people with elite knowledge in some area are ignorant of more ordinary things! The veterinarian who euthanized Capa to spare her death by pulmonary failure, in a discussion weeks earlier, had no knowledge

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of the human tooth regeneration achieved in 2011 at Columbia University Dental Lab. There are things all of us want to know, if ONLY someone would inform us!

There is nothing besides my own demise that will prevent me from contacting anyone and everyone necessary, shaking this tree over a period of years if necessary, to see that improvement in public information takes place. Not all pet owners acquire a dog by way of a city shelter or private rescue group to guarantee spay in females. The last three dogs that resided here all came as obviously abandoned and the first two were males, one from a roadside rest stop east of Dallas. More details are in the document.


